**Addendum #3**

The purpose of this Addendum is to modify the Contract Documents for the subject project.

This Addendum shall become part of said Contract Documents.

Each bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum in his/her bid proposal.

**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS:**

Item 1. QUESTION: *Is there an approximate SF of assumed sensitive plant salvage that bidders can use to formulate an accurate cost for that scope of work?*

RESPONSE: Sensitive plant salvage only applies to the construction footprint of the dune berms. The square footage of sensitive plants within the dune berm footprint has not been quantified. The presence of sensitive plants in this area is generally sparse and varies spatially and seasonally due to periodic disturbance from wave over-wash, wind-blown sand and off-highway vehicle use. The sensitive plants will be identified and flagged in the field by the Project Botanist prior to construction, and salvage will be limited to those individual plants located within the footprint.
